Winemakers Notes

2013 was a warm year, and this translates into a ripe yellow peach character for the vintage. On the nose you'll note a creamy peach and vanilla note, with a hint of citrus peel. On the palate, think of a lemon-lime meringue with fresh peach, followed by some citrus blossom minerality and light oak on the long finish. Drink now through 2017.

Hand harvested, whole cluster pressed, barrel fermented in neutral French oak barrels, aged sur lie for 7 months, batonnage twice per month.
