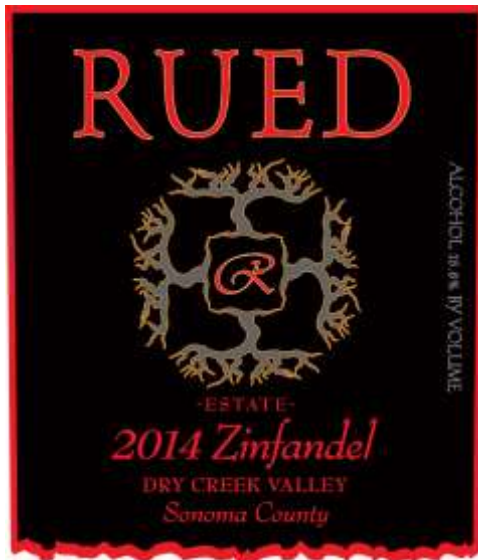

Tasting Notes

Our Estate Zinfandel is grown on the eastern bench of sun-drenched Dry Creek Valley. It exhibits a luscious fragrance of Bing cherries, blackberry pie and black pepper. A classic style Zinfandel infused with bright flavors of blackberry, cherry cola, vanilla, and black pepper. The firm tannins and long finish resolve pleasantly on the palate.

Winemaker Notes

The grapes were harvested from the estate vineyard also known as the "Home Ranch". They were picked at optimal ripeness to assure structure and balance. After fermentation, winemaker Steve Rued and his wife, Sonia, aged the wine in 100% French oak barrels of varying age. It remained in barrel for 19 months before bottling.
