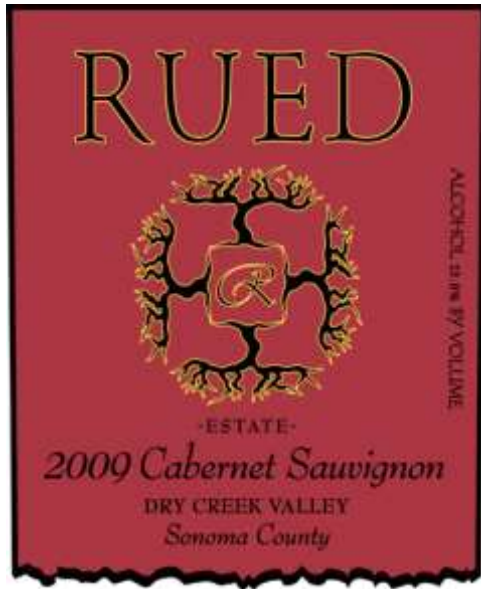

Tasting Notes

The wine is near opaque purple-garnet in color, with enticing aromas of Bing cherry, black pepper, cocoa and hints of cardamom spice. Mouth-filling flavors of black current and blackberry expand on the palate with round, firm, dry tannins. Notes of French vanilla and clove accent the long, rich finish. A balanced, medium-bodied Cabernet. Pairs well with grilled beef and leg of lamb.

Winemaker Notes

This elegant, richly flavored estate Cabernet Sauvignon is made by winemakers Steve Rued and his wife, Sonia. Twice-daily pump-overs during fermentation and extended maceration on the skins softened the tannins and added complexity. Made in a fruitforward, lower-oak style, the wine was aged for 30 months in French oak barrels, using more older oak barrels than new.
