Indie Spirits Expo Top Spirits to Try #3: Mery-Melrose Organic Cognac VSOP

"Organic is something people don't usually think about when picking out hard liquor. I don't even think I realized that booze could be organic before this? Anyway, this organic Cognac may be the most interesting brandy I've tried. It has an extremely long finish with pleasing wood tones and hints of vanilla. There are many notes of other flavors, but they exist in such a complimentary manner, it's like a symphony. It may sound pretentious, but there's no other way to describe it. VSOP: A burnished gold color hints at the lush aromas and flavors to come from this spirit. On the nose, the longer aging is immediately evident with notes of cinnamon, vanilla, and honey, but the wood is balanced with a still-lively expression of fruit. The scent of dried apricots and figs mingles with rose petals and pain d'episces. The first sip saturates the palate with a soft, silky robe of warm spices and tropical fruits, with notes of brown sugar and persimmon emerging with successive sips. The long, fruity finish ends with a gentle sweetness reminiscent of ripe grapes. Enjoy it neat or over ice.
